## **SQA Appeals Service**

SQA offer a service this session for those candidates who wish to appeal their grade. SQA are clear that if appealing it should relate to one of the categories below.

- an appeal against the academic judgement made
- an appeal against an unresolved administrative error
- an appeal on grounds of discrimination (for example, a breach of the Equality Act)

#### A reason must be provided to support your request.

If proceeding, SQA are clear that the grade can remain the same, move up or move down.
