Phased Return - March 2021

Senior Phase

Rationale

Our aim is to maximise learning in NQ courses and retain the structured timetable that we currently have in place. This will ensure there is minimal disruption to our online learning provision for S1 to S6. We are currently providing high quality remote learning and have high levels of engagement. This will be enhanced by face to face learning for all S4 to S6 pupils in all their subjects each week.

Plan

- 50% of the Senior Phase (SP) will attend at a time.
- S4 to S6 year groups will be divided into Group 1 and Group 2 and follow the same pattern of attendance each week (see below).
- We will retain the 3 session a day timetable so that the BGE remote timetable can continue (see below).
 Pupils are in a daily routine with twice weekly contact with class teachers that we do not wish to compromise.
- The first SP session will start at 9.30am to allow staff time to upload work for remote learning (8.45 to 9.30am).
- Interval will be removed to avoid pupils congregating in groups.
- Pupils will attend half day sessions to avoid compromising the 2-metre distancing in place in classrooms.
- Practical sessions already planned and underway can continue including additional Friday sessions.

- This model will ensure that each week all pupils have face to face contact with their teacher in every subject for a block of 1.5 hours.
- Teachers will not be able to engage with remote learners while teaching the other half of the class in school, therefore, work will be set in the same way as current practice. Pupils will work independently and support will be provided during in-school sessions.
- Time is built into the week for staff to prepare online tasks and resources.
- Childcare hub and BGE/SP Support Hubs can continue.

Broad General Education

Rationale

Remote learning will continue to be the main vehicle for delivery in the BGE. Our current provision ensures pupils have a structured week with timetabled interactions at least twice a week with their teachers. The quality of the online learning is very good and in-school provision will be limited when built round the SP timetable. Any in-school provision will prioritise literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing promoting recovery and reconnection. Engagement in remote learning has been very strong in S1 and S2 and we wish to minimise disruption to this before our full return after Easter. Our plans for BGE are as follows.

- Reconnect with all young people in S1 to S3, focus on wellbeing and prepare them for returning to school full time.
- **Target groups** of young people who have not engaged well during lockdown to consolidate key learning required for their return to school.
- **Target groups** of young people who require additional support to support their learning with sessions in Pupil Support.

Plan for Target Groups

- Sessions will run 9 to 11.30am Monday to Thursday.
- We will increase the number of groups running each week as we test capacity for 2 metre distancing and safe movement to and around school of all the different groups of learners.

Plan for all S1 and S2

- S1 will attend on Friday 19 March from 8.55 to 12.20.
- S2 will attend on Friday 26 March from 8.55 to 12.20.
- Start time and end time will stagger arrival and departure of BGE and SP pupils.
- Each register class will be split into bubbles to allow 2-metre physical distancing.
- They will follow a reduced timetable (see below).
- They will remain in the period 1 classroom and the teacher will go to them.
- The interval will be spent in the classroom with 2m distancing remaining in place.

Plan for all S3

- S3 will attend one afternoon each week.
- S3 will be moving into National Qualifications in June so we are maximising the available time to reengage them with routines and learning. Their engagement has been lower than other year groups and there is a need for a strong focus on recovery and reengagement.
- Start time and end time will stagger arrival and departure of BGE and SP pupils.
- Each register class will be split into bubbles to allow 2-metre physical distancing.
- 5 register groups will become 11 bubbles.
- 4 bubbles will attend each afternoon 4 teachers will be required each period.

Appendix

The main points from the Scottish Government statement on 2 March 2021 are as follows.

- Maximise the number of children and young people who are receiving in-school learning with the priority given to learners who are taking National Qualifications.
- Where possible, ensure all learners in secondary schools receive some in-school education each
 week, for example, to help the school re-connect with learners, support their health and wellbeing
 and support the transition back to full time schooling.
- Maintain provision for key worker children and vulnerable learners.
- Prioritise the subject areas and cohorts of learners where there is greatest need as identified by the school, for example, targeted support for learners who may struggle with the transition back to secondary school.
