1. English, Maths, French, RE and PE are compulsory.
2. Young people must choose 1 subject choice in each of the Curricular Areas. **All young people must make a 1st Choice and a Second choice selection for each Column. If an Options form is not returned or returned incomplete the school will make a selection for you based on your latest school report.** The number of periods for each choice is indicated at the bottom of the table overleaf.
3. Pupils should select their combination of subjects they wish to study. Pupils should identify a 1st and 2nd choice.
4. Physics appears in the Science Column and the Technologies Column – it must only be chosen in one Curricular Area
5. Every effort will be made to meet pupil's first choices, but in the event that uptake is too low for classes to run or classes are oversubscribed the second choice will be considered. If fewer than 10 pupils request a subject then that class may not run and your second choice of subject will be used.
6. In Columns 5 and 6, it is free choice of subject to allow young people the opportunity to have a breadth of learning across all curricular areas. Young people are also asked to choose one reserve subject per column in case a class does not run due to low numbers.
7. **Whereby every effort will be made to satisfy subject requests we cannot guarantee to give the same priority consideration to forms returned after this date as to forms returned on time.**
8. **No further change requests will be able to be made to individual selected option choices after 05/02/21 unless in exceptional circumstances.**
